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10 ways to use Baking Soda around the home

Baking Soda is not only cheap to buy but more importantly it's nontoxic. This natural product, also known as sodium bicarbonate, doesn't only make your cakes taste better, but it also improves your life in the most toxic-free and eco-friendly way

1. **Unclog your sink.** Mix one cup of baking soda and one cup of vinegar and pour down your drain to unclog it.
2. Brighten your **silver** with a baking soda and water paste. Rub onto silver with a clean cloth, rinse, and dry. This is also good for removing tea stains from cups.
3. Brighten your **floors.** Get rid of grime easily by mixing half a cup of baking soda in a bucket of warm water. Mop and rinse clean for a shiny floor.
4. Deodorize and cleanse your **dishwasher** by putting baking soda in the wash cycle.
5. Add baking soda to a sponge and clean the insides of your microwave and reduce odours.
6. Sprinkle baking soda on the bottom surface of your **oven** and spray with water to dampen the soda. Let sit overnight and scrub in the morning, rinsing thoroughly.
7. A wet cloth with baking soda will remove **crayon** marks from a wall.
8. Remove baking residue by shaking a generous amount of soda onto **pots and pans.** Add hot water and washing up liquid, soak for 15 minutes and wash.
9. Place a cup of baking soda to deodorize your **refrigerator.**
10. Sprinkling baking soda on the bottom of your **rubbish** bin will keep unfortunate smells away
