The Minutes of last Quarterly Meeting were read & signed.

The Report of the County Surveyor on the state of the roads in the District, and his Proposals for payment or otherwise to Road Contractors (as on Form 22) were read & approved.

The following Applications for new works, made by the County Surveyor were approved.

To embank & widen Road No 7, at James Queeney's Street near Kiltown Church. £10-0-0

To build 10 perches of protection wall on South side of Road No 23, near Ballygatta 3 roads. £10-0-0

To build a gullet between Mrs Leonard's & Mrs Muldoon's lands, near Lamone Cross Roads on Road No 35. £3-0-0.

On consideration of applications for New Works by District Councillors, it was proposed by Mr J. Kelly, seconded by Mr Fallon, that all

the Applications be rejected.

Proposed by Mr J. Hughes as an amendment, seconded by Mr Dowling that each work be considered on its merits.

The Amendment of Mr Hughes was carried by 11 to 6 votes.

Proposed by Mr Beades & seconded by Mr Martin that all applications for New Works be passed.

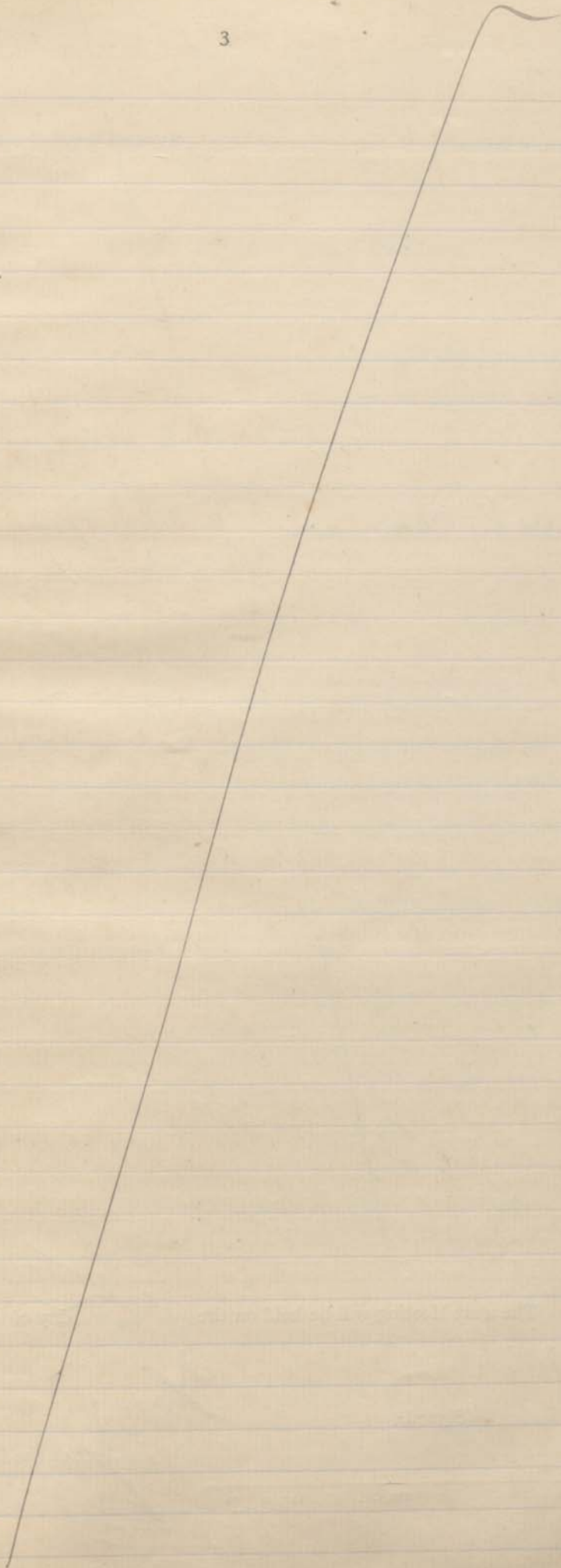
Proposed by Mr Bannon as an amendment & seconded by Mr Shine that each work be taken separately.

Mr Naughten proposed, Mr Tallon seconded and it was carried on a division by 11 to 7 votes, that in cases where Councillors have more than one Application standing in their name, only one Application be passed.
