Quarter, 22 may be paid in full or with small
deductions and 42 must be deferred.

On the motion of Mr Feely (K), seconded
by Mr Hughes the Report was adopted.

The recommendations for payment or otherwise to
as in Form 22 were read and approved.

On a division the amendment of Mr Larkin was carried by 9 votes to 8



