No 8, to provide, soling and metalling
for road in Curraneaball & Drumlish.

For road No 9, to provide new bridge
at Clonawon one tender, from John
Fallon, at £57, was received &
accepted.

For road No 10, four tenders were
received, viz:—The Fallon £50-0-0
O'Neill £48-5-0. Mr. Downey £48-
& Mr. O'Neill & Bother £47-15-0

John Kelly, one of the sureties named
in the last tender, stated that he
would not sign the bond.

Proposed by Mr. Kelly, and
seconded by Mr. Glennon that the
tender of Mr. Downey, being the
next lowest be accepted

Proposed by Mr. Keilly, seconded
by Mr. Shene, and carried on a
division by 7 votes to 6 that no

tender be accepted, and that the work be referred to the County Council.

In view of considering the tender the clerk reported that one tender was lodged after the stipulated time.

Proposed by Mr Gleason and seconded by Mr Logan that the tender be considered

Proposed by Mr Haupten, seconded by Mr Fedy, & carried by 8 votes to 7 that the tender be not considered
