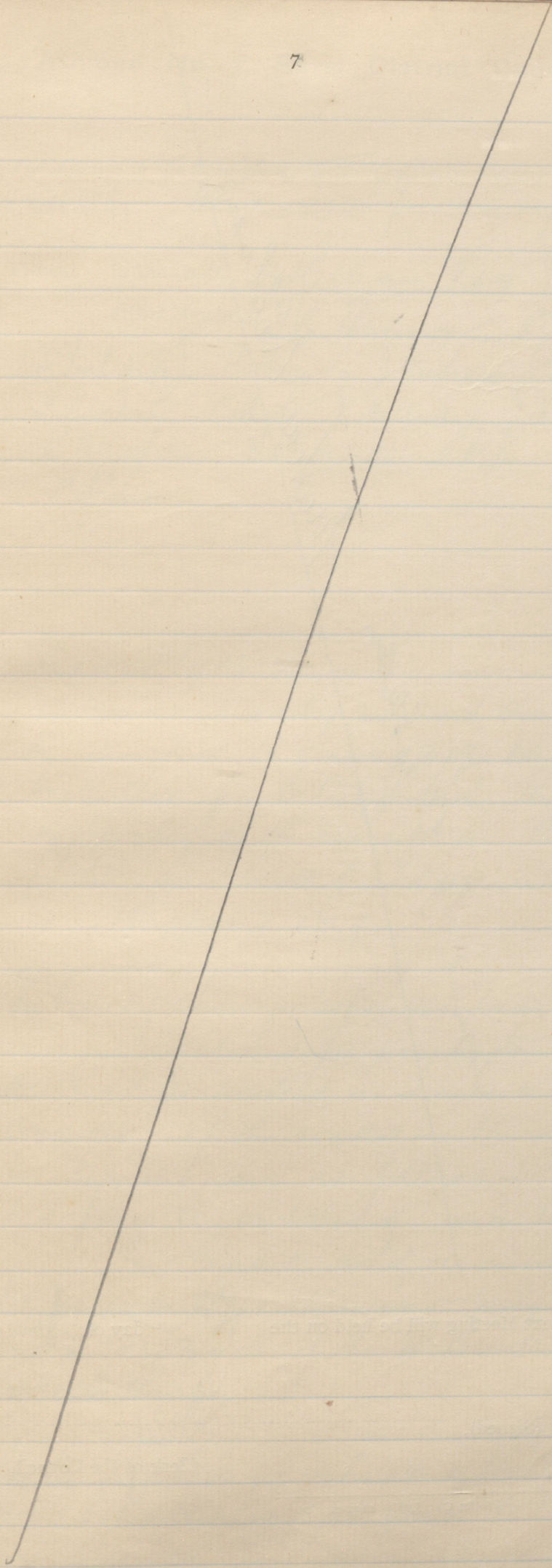
No tenders were received for Works Nos 3, 10 12 & 14.
