

The Minutes of the Proceedings of the Quarterly Meeting of the above Council, held on the 6th day of January 1912

Proposed by the Chairman, seconded by Mr W Beades and unanimously resolved that the Clerk be directed to convey to Mr Edward Tallon, Councillor for Baltragh B.D., the deep sympathy of the Members on the tragic death of his son Const M. Tallon who was drowned in Rosapoint Bay

The County Surveyor submitted Form 22 with his recommendations for payment or otherwise to Road Contractors, and reported that the condition of the roads in the District may be summarised as follows, - 16 were good; 45 fair or middling; and three, bad.

The Report and recommendations for payment or otherwise were approved, on the motion of Mr W Beades, seconded by Mr A. Percy

The County Surveyor submitted his Estimate of Road Expenditure for year to 31st March 1913 as follows, - Continuous Maintenance £1,621;

Special Works £400 - Total £1,962-, and reported that owing to non fulfilment of contracts and to the fact that works are contracted for at less than the estimated amount, the Council could safely reduce the estimate by £200- if they so desired.

Proposed by Mr Beades, seconded by Mr Perry and resolved "that the estimate be reduced by £134- being an equivalent of 1% in £ on the Valuation".

The County Surveyor's proposals for road maintenance contracts were read and approved as marked on sheet herewith.

Twelve applications for New Works, from District Councillors were received and dealt with as marked on sheet herewith.

Ordered that the Adjourned Quarterly Meeting for the consideration of Tenders be held on Saturday the 24th January at 12 o'clock noon.
