

The Minutes of the Proceedings of the Quarterly Meeting of the above Council, held on the 6th day of *Apr* 1912

Read report from Co. Surveyor stating that of the 64 roads under maintenance in the District, 61 were fair or middling & 3 were bad & recommending that a contract be taken for rebuilding 3 furlots on road Nos 26 & 54 at a cost of £15—

On the motion of Mr Reilly seconded by Mr Percy the report was adopted.

The recommendations of the County Surveyor for payment or otherwise to road contractors were read and approved.

Read letter from Sec. Co. Council stating that £10— was spent on special works & £75-0 on sudden damage in the District during the Quarter.

19 applications for New Works as on form hereunder were received from District Councilors.

Proposed by Mr Kelly and seconded by Mr Larkin that all applications be rejected except Nos 7, 9, & 13.

Proposed by Mr McDonnell & seconded by Mr Martin Dammion that each application be considered & dealt with on its merits.

On a division Mr Kelly's motion was carried by 15 votes to 11.

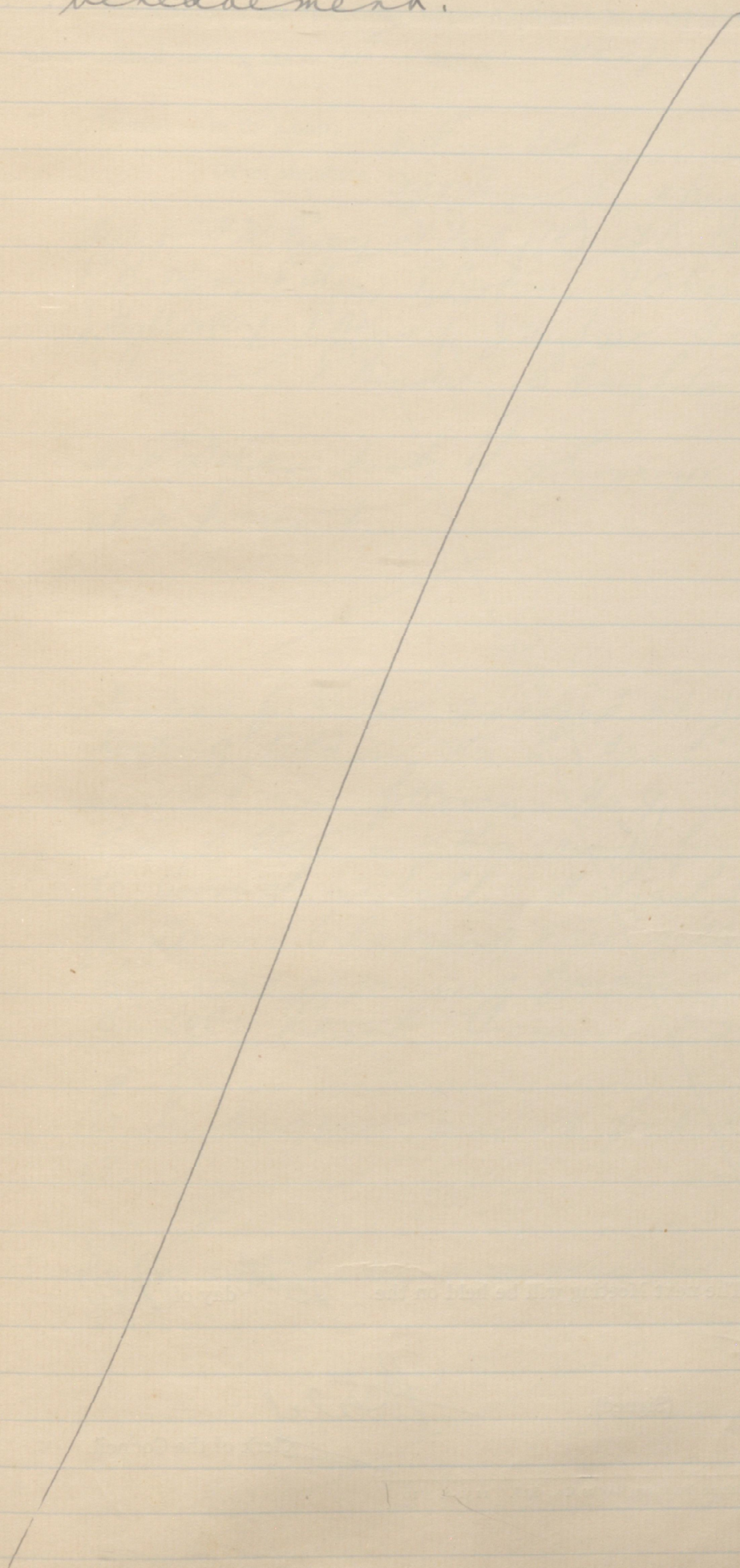
Works Nos 7, 9, & 13 were considered & approved.
