

The Minutes of the Proceedings of the Quarterly Meeting of the above
Council, held on the 5th day of October 1912

The County Surveyor reported that the condition
of the public contracts in the district is
indicated from his recommendations
on Form 22, by which it may be
seen that out of 63 instalments of
continuous contracts 3 are to be
paid in full, 52 paid in part &
part deferred and 8 deferred; that
at the recent inspection of the roads
the surfaces described by the Assistant
as fair could only be classed as
middling, and in a few cases
they did not come up to that
distinction.

The report was approved

The recommendations for payment or
otherwise to road contractors as made
by the County Surveyor on Form 22
were read & approved.

Read letter from Ashburn Urban Council stating that they intend constructing a footpath on the Milton road to the Bore Boundary and requesting that the Rural District Council would continue it to the Mill of Berries

Five applications from Rural District Councillors for new works were received.

Proposed by Mr Larkin & seconded by Mr Macken "that all the applications be rejected".

Proposed by Mr Keely, seconded by Mr Hughes, and carried on a division by 7 votes to 5 that each application be considered and dealt with on its merits.
