The County Surveyor submitted Form 22 with his recommendations as to payments to road contractors, and reported that the conditions of the roads were as follows:— 13 good, 49 fair or middling, and 2 bad; that the County Council referred to him a proposal to plant trees on the sides of the roads to enhance their appearance; that the cost would be about £18 per mile and he requested the opinion of the Council on the matter.

The recommendations on form 22 were approved and it was ordered that the Council do not approve of the proposed planting.

The County Surveyor's recommendations for new Maintenance contracts on the

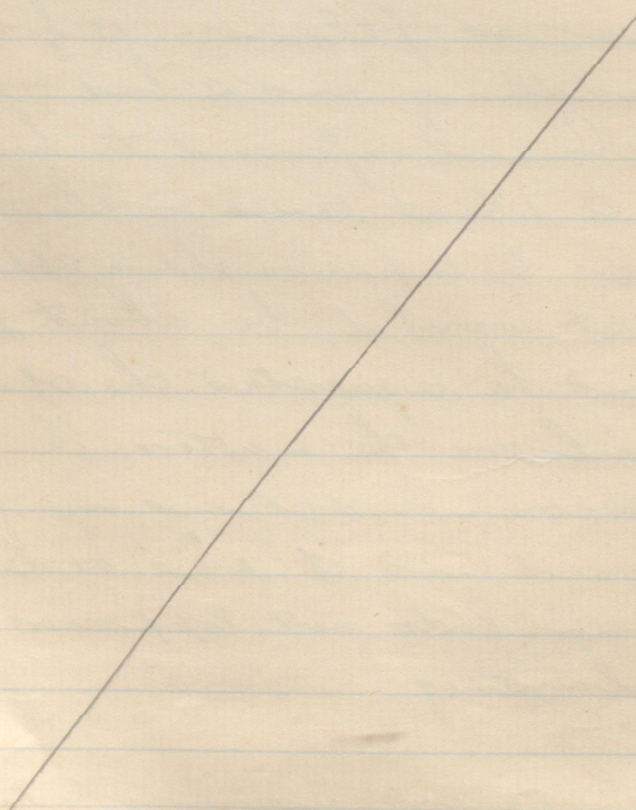

were approved

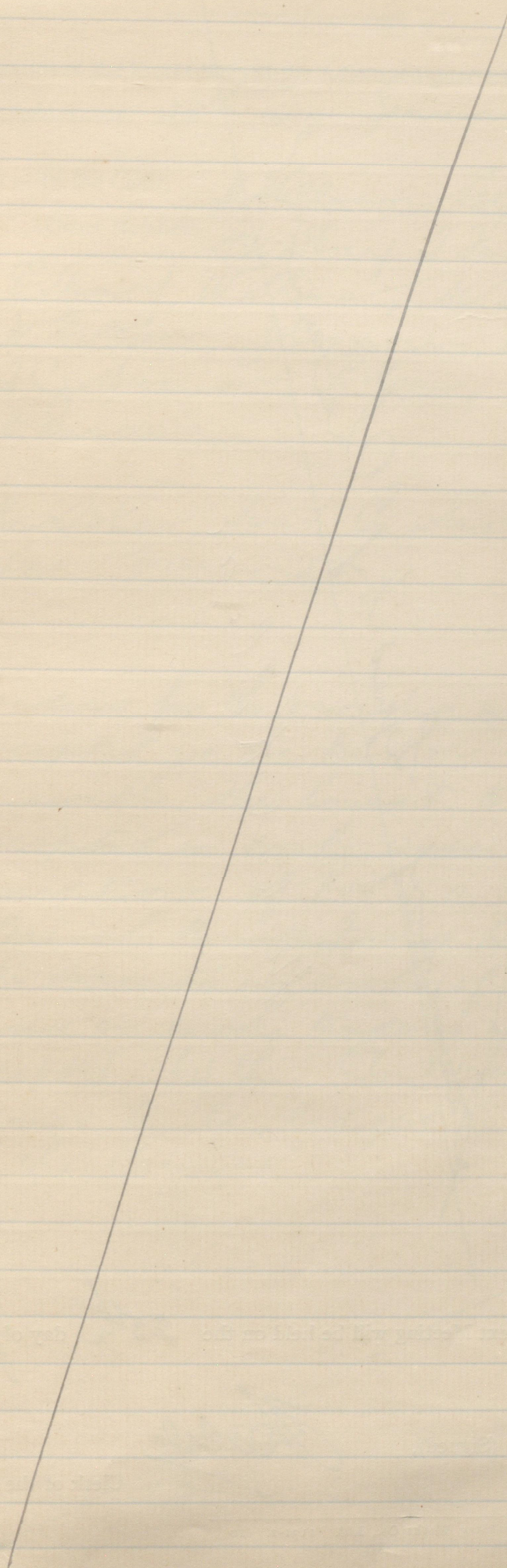
The County Surveyor's estimate of
