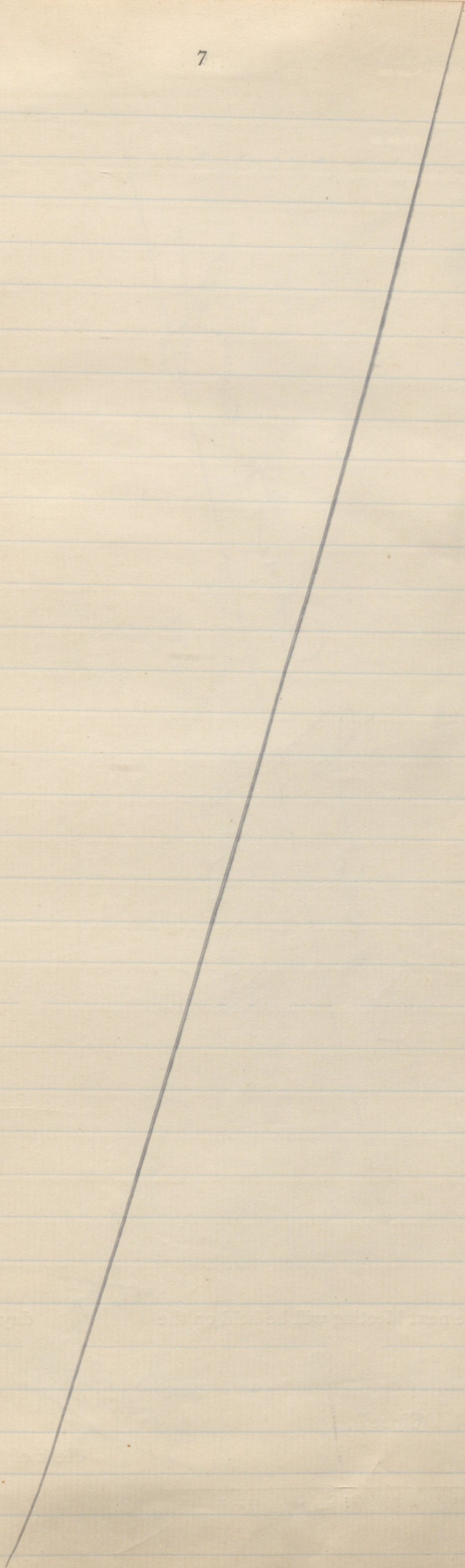

SPECIAL WORKS.

- To repair 400 perches of road from off the road from Athlone to Ballinasloe, commencing at Michael Naughten's, Churchpark, by Taghmaconnell and leading to the Village..... Cost not to exceed 10 0 0
- To repair about 500 perches from Milltownpass to Curraghmore, and raise same over high-water mark. Cost not to exceed 15 0 0
- To build 4 perches of protecting wall on the road from Cam to Ballygar..... Cost not to exceed 6 0 0
- To repair 402 perches of the road from Mullaghardagh cross to the District boundary at Jamestown. Cost not to exceed 5 12 6

Specifications can be seen and Forms of Tender obtained at my office, the Workhouse, Athlone, on Friday, the 24th January, 1913.

Tenders must be lodged at my Office not later than 4 o'clock, p.m., same day.

The sum of £1 must be handed in by the Contractor for each Tender Form applied for, which will be returned after the Council Meeting if a genuine Tender is received. If no Tender be received on the Form, or if a Bogus Tender be lodged, the deposit will be forfeited.

Every Tender must be signed by the person making the Tender, and enclosed in a sealed envelope, marked on the outside "Tender for No." and must state:—

(a). The lowest sum for which the person tendering is willing to Contract for the performance of the work.

(b). The description and address of the person Tendering; and

(c). The names of the Guarantors for the performance of the Contract.

The Guarantors shall be two landholders who are willing to be bound as sureties for the due performance of the Contract. The attendance of the Guarantors at the Meeting will be necessary.

The Council may, at their discretion, accept the lowest or any Tender, or may reject every Tender.

The acceptance of any Tender shall be provisional on the approval by the County Council of the Tender.
