Two proposals for new works were received as on sheet herewith.

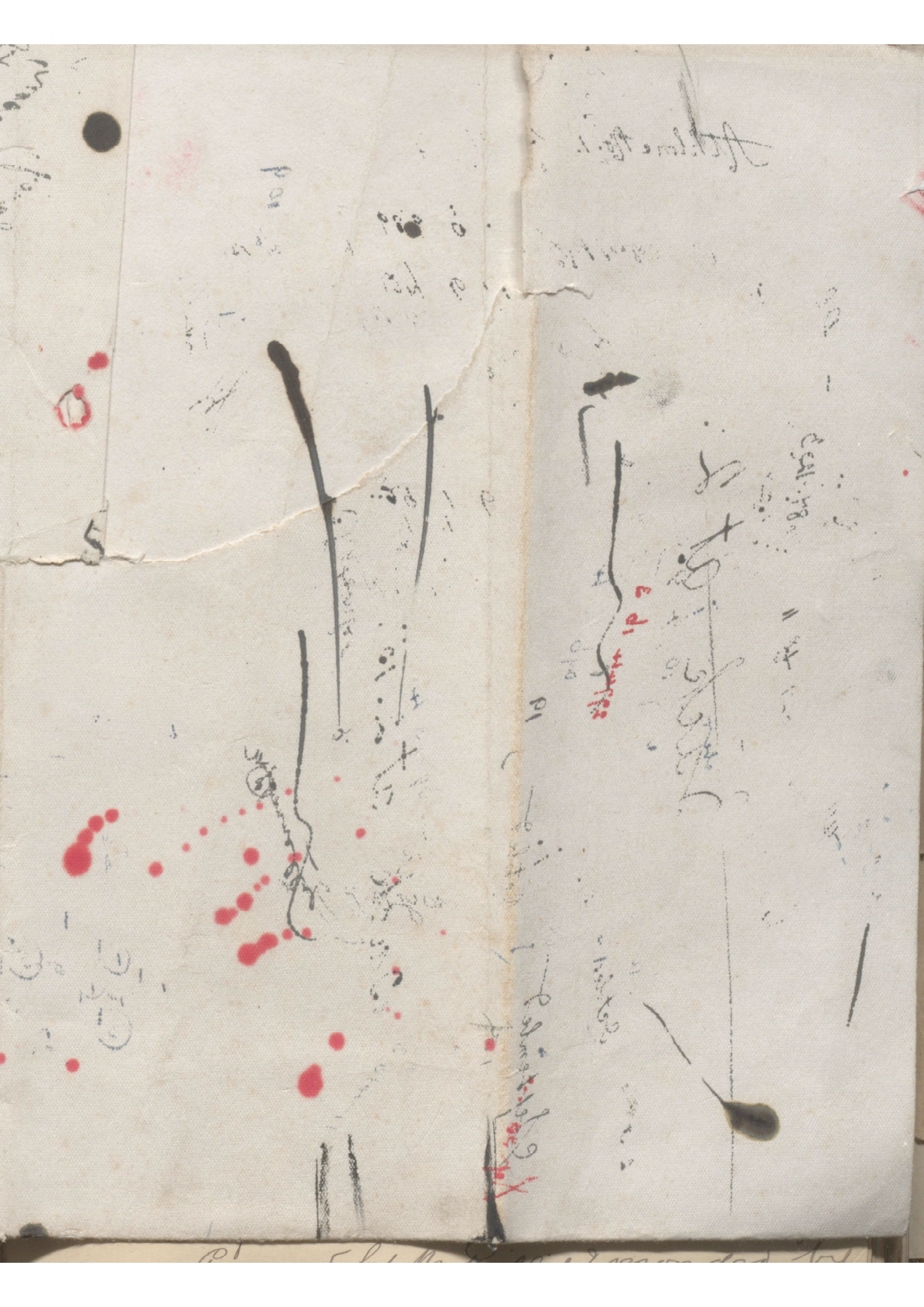
