

The Minutes of the Proceedings of the Quarterly Meeting of the above Council, held on the 5th day of July 1913.

Proposed by the Chairman, seconded by Mr W. Shine and unanimously resolved that this Council tender to Mr C. Mulvanny, Co Surveyor, their sincere sympathy on the death of his wife, and that the Clerk be directed to convey to Mr Mulvanny and family the expression of the Council's feelings with them in their bereavement.

Read report from County Surveyor stating that at the recent inspections the roads in the district were fair or middling; that sufficient attention is not given to surface labour by the Contractors, and he has called their attention to same, and submitting form 22 with his recommendations for payment or otherwise to road Contractors.

The report was approved as were also the recommendations made by the Co Surveyor

on form 22.

Read letter from Mrs M. Egan objecting to any of her land being taken to widen road as proposed in application No 11.

Ordered that the letter be sent to the County Council with form 20.

15 applications from Councillors for new works, as on sheet herewith, were received:

Proposed by Mr J. Kelly and seconded by Mr Feely that only one work be granted to each Councillor applying for more than one.

Proposed by Mr Scully and seconded by Mr McManus that each application be considered and dealt with on its merits.

On a division Mr Kelly's motion was carried by 10 votes to 6.

The applications were then considered and dealt with as marked on sheet herewith.
