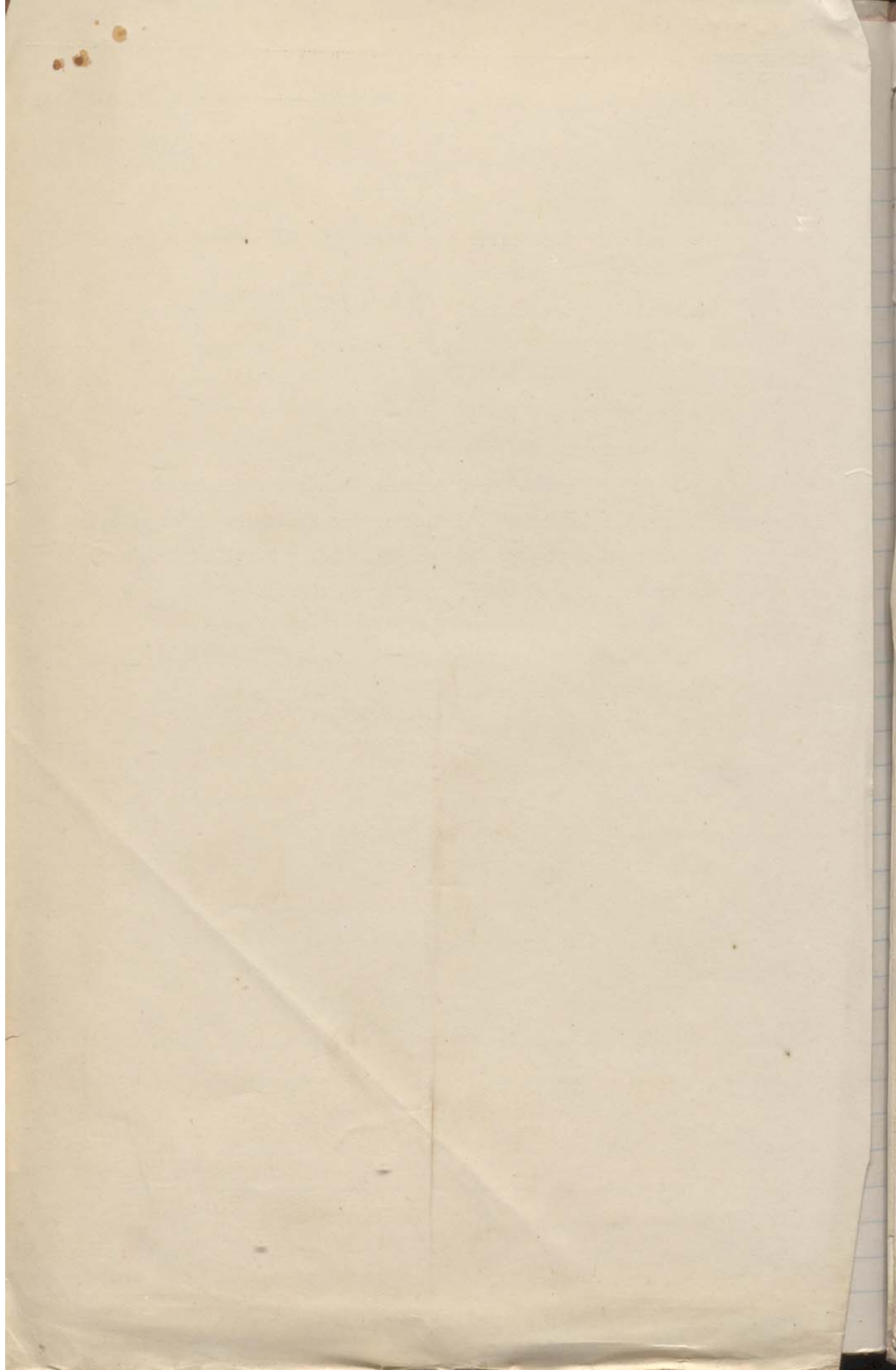

Report of the County Surveyor
to the Boyle No. 1. Rural District
Council, for the Quarter ended
31st December 1924,

Gentlemen,

I return herewith Form 22 into which I have entered my recommendations and which shows that the one instalment deferred from last meeting must be again deferred. The Contractor for this work is prevented from going on with the work owing to the severe weather.

At the time of the recent inspection the condition of the surfaces of the roads was as follows:-
3 were good, 111 were fair, 18 middling and 2 bad.

The past year and particularly the past quarter has been very trying on the road surfaces. Some of the Trunk and Main Roads which I had succeeded in getting into good shape during the Summer, with gravel, have been badly damaged. In places the whole surfaces have been washed away by floods and are costing a lot to keep.

No provision was made in last year's Estimate for such unforeseen contingencies and consequently in some sections the expenditure has been very high with the result that I have had to close down work in them.

However taking the whole Rural District the expenditure has been reasonable. The amount allowed was £ 6,050 : : and the amount spent is £ 5,027 : : You will see
