

Minutes of the Proceedings of a Special Meeting of the Roscommon County Council held at the Courthouse, Roscommon, on Wednesday, the 14th February, 1912, convened by the direction of the Chairman for the purpose of considering representations, with reference to the Direct Labour Scheme and to make a final declaration of the Direct Labour Scheme for the term 1912-1915.

Mr. Fitzgibbon, Chairman, presided:-
The following members were in attendance:- Councillors Durr, Waters, Kelly, Grogan, Conry, Millar, Gilbooly, Shanley, O'Brien, Regan, M'Donnell, Doyle, and J. McGuire.

The Secretary submitted letters from the Clerks of the District Councils of Athlone, Castlebar and Strokestown with reference to the Scheme of Direct Labour and stated that no objections were received by him against the Scheme.

The Secretary submitted the Scheme which was provisionally adopted by the Council at the Quarterly Meeting held on the 30th November, 1911.

The Council passed the following resolution finally adopting the Direct Labour Scheme.
Proposed by Councillor John Fitzgibbon.

Seconded by Councillor Patrick Regan.
And Resolved :-

" That we, the County Council of the County of Roscommon hereby make this final declaration that all the roads listed in the accompanying Schedule of roads, viz :- All of the continuously maintained roads of Ballyrea, Roscommon and Strokestown Rural Districts, and certain selected roads of Boyle No. 1 Rural District, are suitable to be maintained by Direct Labour under the charge of the County Surveyor, and we formulate the accompanying Scheme for carrying the same into effect. That the Secretary be directed to affix the Seal of the Council to this Resolution and the Scheme".
