Notice in relation to Specified Development**

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 179 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) and Article 81 of Part 8 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended) that Roscommon County Council proposes to carry out the following works:

L-7610 / L-7550 Killaghahan and Gort and Carnagh West Road Realignment

Location	Description
Junction of L-7610 and L-7550 in the townland of Killiaghan and Gort, Co. Roscommon	Construction of 76m of new roadway to form a new junction of the L-7610 and L-7550 roads to improve sight lines and safety. Removal of 120m of the L-7610 and the existing junction of the L-7610 and L-7550 roads

An Appropriate Assessment screening report and Environmental Impact Assessment screening report in respect of the development have been carried out and are available for inspection. The reports concluded that a full EIAR is not required, and that the development does not need to proceed to Stage 2 appropriate assessment. Where any person considers that a development proposed to be carried out would be likely to have significant effects on the environment, he or she may, at any time before the expiration of four weeks beginning on the date of publication of the notice referred to in Article 81(2), apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination as to whether the development would be likely to have such effects.

Plans and Particulars of the proposed development may be inspected or purchased at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy for a period of **four weeks from 23rd July 2024** during public opening hours at the offices of Roscommon County Council, Áras an Chontae, Roscommon Town, F42 VR98 and the Athlone Municipal District Office, Monksland Civic Centre, Monksland, Athlone, Co.
