



**PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT 2000
REQUEST FOR SECTION 57 DECLARATION**

The above Act provides that any works which would affect the character of a protected structure, or a proposed protected structure will require planning permission, even where those works would normally be exempt under Section 4 (1)(h) of the 2000 Act.

As an owner or occupier of a protected structure you are entitled under the above act to request Roscommon County Council to issue a declaration as to the type of works which may or may not be permitted in your structure. In order to issue this declaration, you should supply the following:
