

The Minutes of the Proceedings of the Quarterly Meeting of the above Council, held on the ^{7th} day of October 1911

Read Report from County Surveyor on the state of the roads in the District, and stating that the time has now arrived when a new Direct Labour Scheme will be considered by the County Council, and suggesting that as Contract system does not expire until 1913, the Contract system should be continued until then.

The Report was approved

Proposed by Mr E. J. Egan, seconded by Mr M. Reilly, and unanimously resolved that as the contracts for the principal roads in this Rural District do not expire until 1st April 1913, we do not propose to adopt Direct Labour in this District yet. We have no objection to the Direct Labour system being used in other Rural Districts in the County.

Read Report from County Council stating that £25- was spent for Special Works in the Rural District during the Quarter ended the 30th September.

On the motion of Mr John Kelly, seconded by Mr Butler, it was unanimously resolved "that permission be granted to Peter Fallon to make about 40 perches of fence on the road from Athlone to Ballinacree by Drum Chapel at Ardkeenar Hill; the work to be done to the satisfaction of the County Surveyor"

Seventeen applications for New Works were received from District Bouncillors Proposed by Mr Larkin and seconded by Mr Fealy (R) "that all the applications be rejected"

Proposed by Mr Feery and seconded by Mr Hughes "that each application be considered and dealt with on its merits"

On a division, Mr Larkin's motion to reject all the applications, was defeated by 13 votes to 12.


