# BOYLE

## WELCOME GUIDE

Boyle is a town in County Roscommon, Ireland. It is located at the foot of the Curlew Mountains near Lough Key in the north of the county. Carrowkeel Megalithic Cemetery, the Drumanone Dolmen and the lakes of Lough Arrow and Lough Gara are also close by



Situated off the N4 is Lough Key Forest Park, a parkland area that has a visitor centre and activity facilities, including Boda Borg, a puzzle solving activity centre which is a Swedish concept originally unique to Sweden but now has locations in Ireland and the United States.[13] The park covers 800 acres (3.2 km<sup>2</sup>), and was formerly part of the Rockingham estate. This was the seat of the Stafford-King-Harman[14] family who at the end of the nineteenth century held over 30,000 acres (120 km<sup>2</sup>) in north County Roscommon and County Sligo. Rockingham House was designed by John Nash in the early 19th century for the English landlord John King. It had a domed front and 365 windows.[citation needed]



There are several islands on Lough Key. Castle Island is among the better known islands, while Trinity Island contains the ruins of a chapel, linked to the Cistercian monastery in the town. There are two trees growing on the island with interlinked branches, said to mark the graves of Una Bhan Mac Diarmid and Tomás Láidir Mac Coisdealbhaigh, two ill-fated lovers, celebrated in the poem Una Bhan

## KEY ATTRACTIONS

### **The Abbey**

Boyle Abbey seen on the photo above is the ruin of a 12th century monastery built here by the Cistercian order. It was the starting point for the town of Boyle that developed around it.

### **King House**

King House seen above was the manor house of the local aristocratic rulers of the area, the King family who amassed tens of thousands of acres of land. The house is an interactive museum run by the county council. The museum makes for a couple of hours of entertainment for the entire family.

### **The Farmers Market**

Every Saturday there is a farmers market outside the gates of King House. People bring their own cooking, baking and crafts to the town for a delicious West-of-Ireland-type blend of cultures. . The stalls sell any amount of fresh and organic veg, continental bakery products, homemade jams, crafts and so on.

TFI Local Link bus services connect communities throughout rural Ireland as part of the TFI Public Transport Network. They form a network of affordable bus services for everyone who wants to travel to or from local towns and villages. TFI Local Link operate two different types of services: Regular Rural Bus Services and Door-to-Door Bus Services.

Passengers can pay with their TFI Leap Card or TFI Go App on eligible TFI Local Link services.

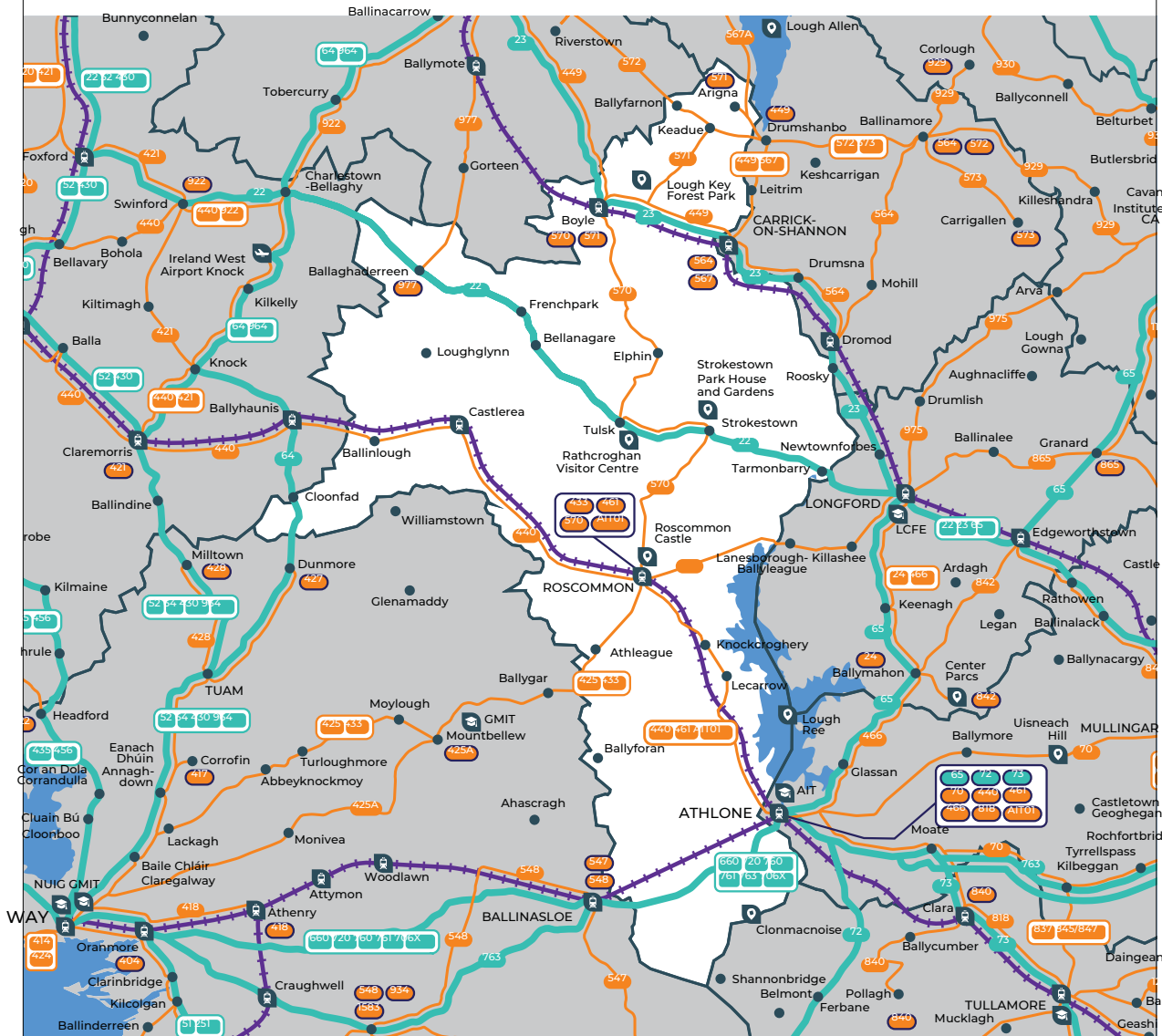

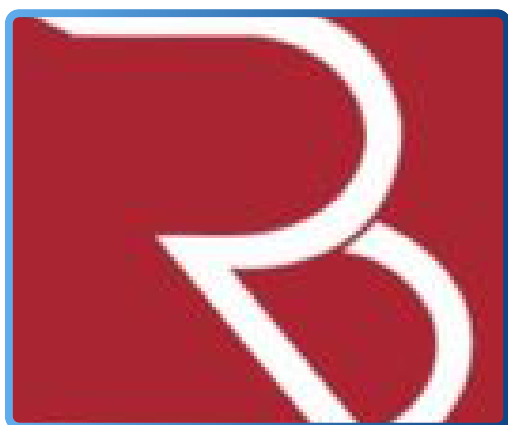

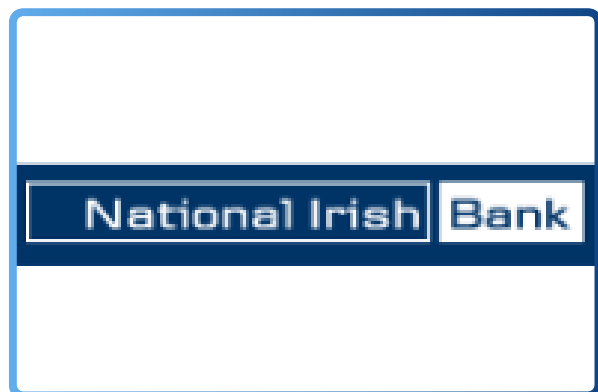
