Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Draft Boyle Local Transport Plan (draft Local Transport Plan).

The Office of the Planning Regulator (Office) acknowledges the work undertaken in preparing the draft Local Transport Plan and the ambition of the plan to inform the land use zoning and the forthcoming Settlement Plan for Boyle. The integration of transport and land use planning is a key principle of national and regional planning policy to support sustainable communities and achieving climate objectives.

In this context, it is recommended that the key outcomes and recommendations arising from the draft Local Transport Plan, together with indicative delivery timelines, are clearly reflected in any future draft statutory plan for Boyle.

Engagement with the prescribed bodies, including the National Transport Authority and Transport Infrastructure Ireland, will also be critical in terms of supporting the prioritisation and early delivery of the proposed recommendations, particularly those relating to active travel and public transport infrastructure.

The Office looks forward to further engagement with Roscommon County Council in relation to the review and assessment of the forthcoming plan for Boyle.
