On behalf of Roscommon County Council, MWP are submitting an application for approval under Section 177AE of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (As Amended) to An Bord Pleanála, to develop an interim flood relief scheme to pump water from Lough Funshinagh and to discharge the water to the Cross River, within the townland of Carrick, in County Roscommon.

The scheme consists of the following:

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- A floating pontoon to provide access from the shore to the pump unit.
- A compound adjacent to the shores of the lough which will accommodate two hydraulic power units to provide power for the submersible pumps, and four diesel fuel tanks.

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The aim of the interim measures is to extract a sufficient volume of water from Lough Funshinagh that will mitigate the possible increase in level prior to developing a permanent scheme and to limit the peak water level to a level that will allow the flood risk to the properties around the lough to be successfully managed. The interim flood relief scheme will be in place for a period of up to 24months and during this period there will be ongoing monitoring of water levels in Lough Funshinagh and in the Cross River.

A Natura Impact Statement (NIS) has been prepared as part of the application for approval in respect of the proposed development.
