A Ukrainian driver can drive in Ireland under temporary protection using their Ukrainian driving license . They don't need to exchange it for an Irish driving license or take a driving test . However, this is only applicable if the driver has a letter from the Minister for Justice confirming that they are a beneficiary of Temporary Protection in Ireland granted under section 60 of the International Protection Act 2015.
